**Concept of the seminar:**

This Seminar is focused on developing different ways of innovative teaching -learning process for the “trainee teachers” who are the future of our society. In teaching, new technologies are adapted to bring changes in the existing system for fulfilment of predetermined educational objectives. In early days, books were the only source of instruction for individualized learning and Individualized teaching. Today this includes huge diversification i.e Online Teaching, e-learning, Constructivist Learning, CAL , CAI etc. It has been proved by various research studies of individuals and institutions that information and communication technology (ICT) can make the teaching learning process more effective and efficient if utilized intelligently. In higher education and in school education, lecture method is popularly used by teachers in the classroom. Although, Lecture Method is useful in completing large content in less time but there are many limitations related to this method, for example, teacher plays dominating role in the class room and students remain passive listeners only. Only a few students interact with the teachers. Many students could not clear their doubts in the classroom. There are some other teaching methods that are also useful in higher education like Constructivist Approach, Demonstration Method, Project method, Inductive and Deductive method, etc. A paradigm shift in teaching-learning is needed to

increase the pupils' active participation and thereby perceptual and cognitive development of the students. The transfer of textual learning contents to visual learning content may be more effective in the process of learning through innovative pedagogy.
